

Applied Projects Funding Program - Office of Sustainability

Do you or your students have an idea about how to make Fleming College more sustainable? Is it something that students could work on in the upcoming fall and winter semesters? This funding program provides money to research or implement small projects that can do this! Please read the following guidelines and timeframes for funding proposals.

Funding Available

The Office of Sustainability is offering funding for four (4) projects at \$1,000 each.

Benefits for Fleming

Resourcing for mission-critical projects is a recurring issue for many organizations. In addition, many projects are put on the back burner precisely because of a lack of resources. Organizations have the ability to make use of bright student minds, with the backing of experienced faculty to address important projects without the usual expenses related to resourcing the projects.

Benefits for Students

There is nothing like real-world situations to cement the learning gained through years of lectures, studying, case studies and simulations. Students learn how to achieve objectives within the constraints of live organizations. They get to meet people in industry, start their network and gain valuable work experience, all with the guidance of highly trained faculty.

Project Eligibility

The projects are intended to provide experiential learning for students in creating a more sustainable post-secondary institution by supporting Fleming's desire to be a college whose "programs and practices demonstrate its commitment to building a sustainable future socially, economically, and environmentally for staff, students and the wider community".

Projects eligible for the Office of Sustainability Applied Project funding can come from any current Fleming program but <u>must</u> directly support the implementation of Fleming's

current Sustainability Plan. Preference will be given to projects which meet either a *Strategy* or complete an *Action* as found in the current year's Plan.

Timing

Project applications are to be submitted by November 10th. The projects are to be completed by the end of the fiscal year: March 31st.

Following the closure of the application process, all applications will be reviewed. The winning projects will be chosen by November 20th and the applicant will be contacted.

Use of Funding

The funds provided are available to be used for the following eligible expenses:

- Travel required to complete the project
- Research cost
- Materials required to complete the project
